Instagram

Click on the last tab located on the far right bottom corner. Select edit your profile and scroll to the bottom and turn photos are private on. This is the only privacy setting so any photos he takes will be shared only with people who he has invited to follow him or who he is following.

- 1. Go to your profile by tapping in the lower-right corner
- 2. Tap **Edit Your Profile** next to your profile picture
- 3. iPhone/iPad: Scroll down to Photos Are Private and toggle the switch to On

Risks:

If the privacy is not on it is open for the world to see any photo you add. For example, he has his camera linked to instagram, meaning any photo he takes on purpose or by mistake is now public because it is uploading onto instagram automatically. Problem with that is if you take a photo of a sibling or yourself in your undies to be funny but its uploading automatically to instagram everyone can see it. Click on the photo icon for photos indicated by the red arrow below and click on the tab (top right corner) indicated by the purple arrow below to change the setting to add manually.
